



A REMINDER

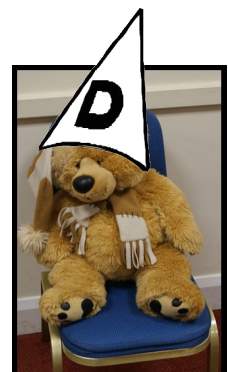
