## **CONSULTANT CONNECT**

**Consultant Connect** is an innovative telecoms system that allows GPs to connect with local Specialty Consultants whilst the patient is with them in the consultation room for immediate advice and guidance.

This service which improves communications between Primary and Secondary care began just over a year ago as a pilot and became live on 30 November 2016.



There has been very positive feedback from both GPs and Consultants about the service which runs during normal GP working hours from 8am until 6pm. The advice and guidance given is recorded so will also be held on the patient records.

The specialities covered at present are Cardiology, Haematology, Respiratory, Renal Medicine, Gynaecology, Gastroenterology, Diabetes and Endocrinology. It is planned to expand the specialities in the near future.

Out of over 1,400 calls since launch, 56% resulted in a referral being avoided.

This has got to be a great initiative, improving efficiency, helping both the Doctors in Primary Care and us as patients.
