When I am not working I enjoy hiking, travelling and photography

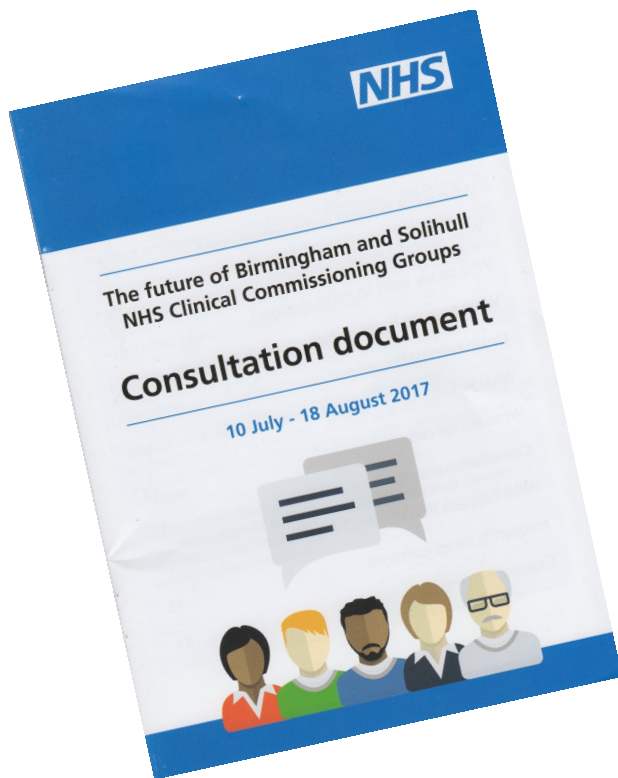


Dr David Fish
