

VACCINATIONS:

SHINGLES

Free Shingles vaccine is available on the NHS for patients of the following age ranges only.

From 1st September 2014 until 31st August 2015 it will be given as a single injection for anyone aged 70, 78 or 79 and, unlike some jabs, you won't need to be re-vaccinated every

To be eligible your date of birth must fall into one of the following groups:

70 years old: 2/9/1943 to 1/9/1944 78 years old: 2/9/1935 to 01/09/1936 79 years old: 2/9/1934 to 1/9/1935

If you wish to have the shingles vaccine and you are not eligible for the NHS vaccination programme, you will usually need to visit a private clinic. Private vaccination is likely to cost £150 - 200.

INFLUENZA OR FLU

Flu (also known as influenza) is a highly infectious illness caused by the flu virus. It spreads rapidly through small droplets coughed or sneezed into the air by an infected person. The flu vaccination is offered to people in at-risk groups. These people are at greater risk of developing serious complications if they catch flu, such as pregnant women and elderly people. Full details of the Criteria are available on our Web site and a printed data sheet available from the Surgery. The dates for the flu vaccination sessions appear on the front cover of this newsletter.

Children aged 2, 3 and 4 years of age will also be given the option of a nasal flu vaccination. Please speak to Reception for details.

BLOOD TESTS

We would like to ask all our patients who are booking in for a blood test to ensure they bring the blood form with them to their appointment

This form will be given to you by the GP who requests that you have a blood test.

The form contains vital information to allow the phlebotomist to ensure the correct tests are carried out (as differ-ent tests require samples to be sent in different blood bottles & sometimes

the quantities differ to).

If the form is not presented at your appointment then we may have to ask you to rearrange to another date.

You can present the form at Solihull hospital phlebotomy walk in service. No appointment is hecessary but you will need to take a blood form from your Doctor. There opening times are as follows:

Monday to Friday 8.00am - 4.00pm Saturday 8.30am – 12.00 midday **Sunday 10.30am – 1.30pm**
